

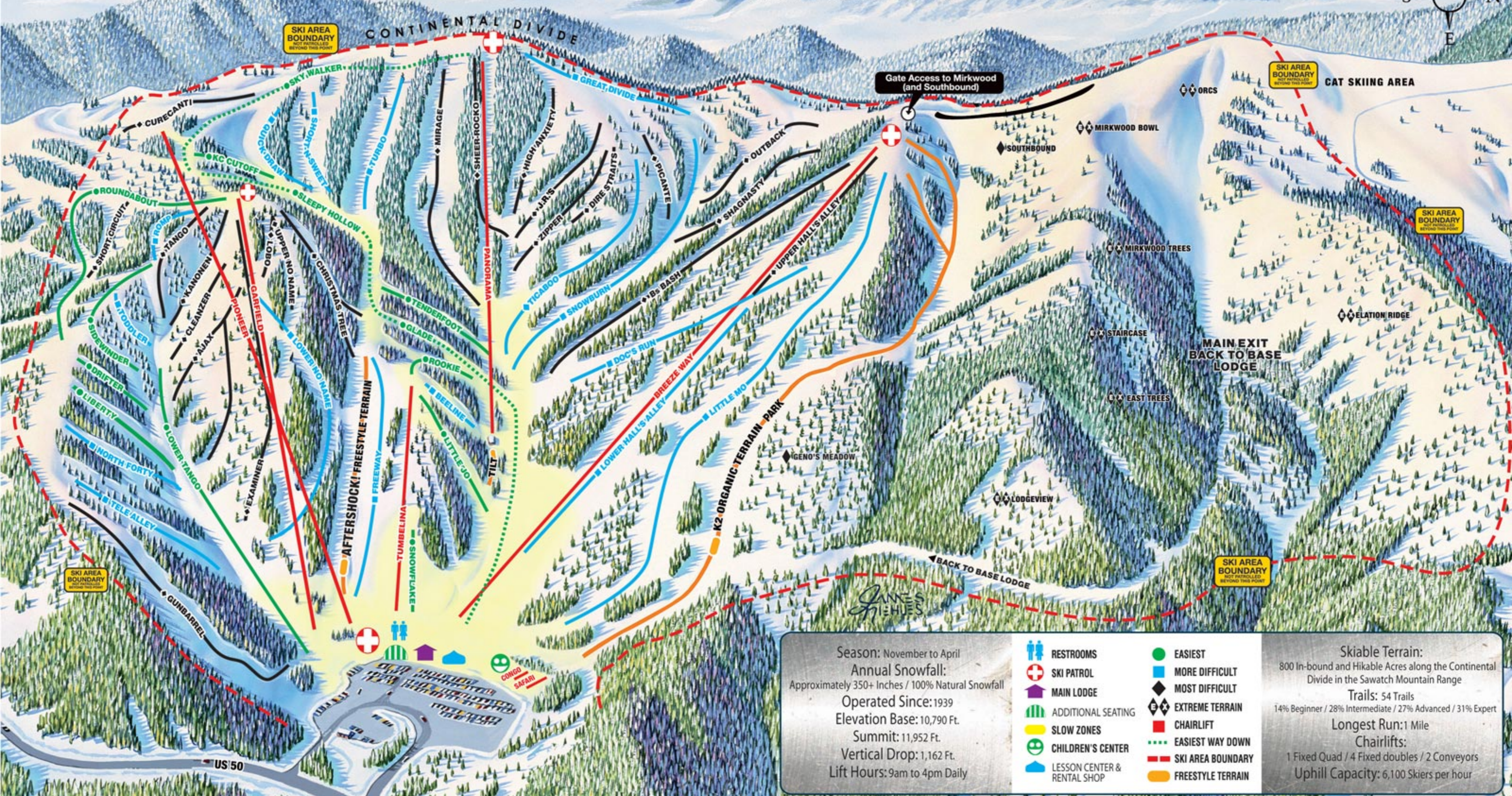


Monarch Mountain is located in the San Isabel National Forest and operates under a special use permit from the US Forest Service. Monarch Mountain is an Equal Opportunity Service Provider.

SLOW ZONES: Yellow areas on the map denote family skiing zones. They indicate approaches to loading and busy traffic areas. Speeding or recklessness in these areas will result in loss of lift ticket. Be advised that all fencing, equipment covers, signage, ropes and other marking devices are in place to inform you of a potential obstacle or hazard. These markers will not protect you from injury. It is your responsibility to stay away from marked areas. The Orange Zone indicates Freestyle terrain which includes but is not limited to terrain parks and terrain park features such as jumps, rails, fun boxes, and other constructed and natural features. **WARNING** Extreme Terrain means "any place within the Ski Area Boundary that contains cliffs with a minimum 20 foot rise over a 15 foot run, and slopes with a minimum 50 degree average pitch over a 100 foot run." **WARNING** Cliff areas WILL be encountered. Use at your own risk. Be very aware of flying skiers and riders!
